Code of Conduct for Club Coaches, Officials and Volunteers

We are fully committed to promoting and protecting the well being of all our registered athletes. Glovertown Gymnastics believes that all registered athletes, coaches, volunteers and parents should at all times show respect and understanding for the safety and well being of others. Therefore, members are encouraged and asked to be open and share any complaints or concerns they may have about any aspect of the sport and club with a head coach or club representative.

The essence of good ethical conduct and practice is outlined below. All club coaches, officials and volunteers must:

- Consider the well being and safety of participants before the development of performance.
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with participants based on mutual trust and respect.
- Hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance.
- Make sure all activities are appropriate for the age, ability and experience of registered athletes to ensure they are both physically and mentally prepared when learning new skills.
- Always coach within their qualifications unless under the supervision of a head club.
- Display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance, dressing suitably and using appropriate language at all times while involved in club activities.
- Always report incidents to head coach of that session immediately or in a timely manner to ensure guidelines are followed appropriately.
- Make sure confidential information is not shared unless with another club coach or official.
- Promote fair play and the positive aspects of the sport.
- Encourage gymnasts to value their individual performance and not just their results in competitions.
- Follow all guidelines laid out by Glovertown Gymnastics.
